

An original producction of theatre and dance about Frida Kahlo's life.

It is said that in the last breath, in the final moment before death, a beam of light appears in front of us. This is the moment chosen by the author to begin telling the story.

Frida watches moments of her perilous life in disorder. She does it as a brush-stroke on a canvas which has always been unfinished. Her personality, fight and sometimes solitude are fused in this performance with love and humour.

"This woman's infinite realms are impressive" the text says.

She does not do this trip in solitude, she will be accompanied by Sardo, an extension of herself, with whom she shares emotions, art and moments of controlled tension... Accompany us as we delve the depths and nuances of Frida's life.

Frida Kahlo was a personality whose life was marked by her fighting, self-improvement and love. She demonstrated that strength and love are the same thing, tools for personal growth.

Inside each creator there is a bit of Frida, because of what in essence she was: rebellious, committed, struggling...The most meaningful aspects of Frida's life are brought to life in the play, the emotions and moments that define her life.

In 2003, Donaldson Dance Company was established, it later became Donaldson Productions and then in 2014 became **Todoart13**.

In 2014, the company moved to the UK with the purpose of working in English. Two productions were translated into English. In that period, it premiered its lastcreation Deus ex Machina (Physical Theatre among other physyical disciplines). Frida Kahlo and Deus ex Machina were performed in Ringwood, Bristol, Brighton, Southampton and West End London.

On 24th March 2021, at 8pm New York time, the Microtheatre version of this performance it was shown at the **9th Season of Micro Theater - Theater SEA in New York**.

Am I solely to blame?, Todoart13's original creation, it was selected to participate in the LGBTI Festival (Fresh Fruit Festival) in New York, in 2013. It was the first time the festival opened the doors to a non English language production.
